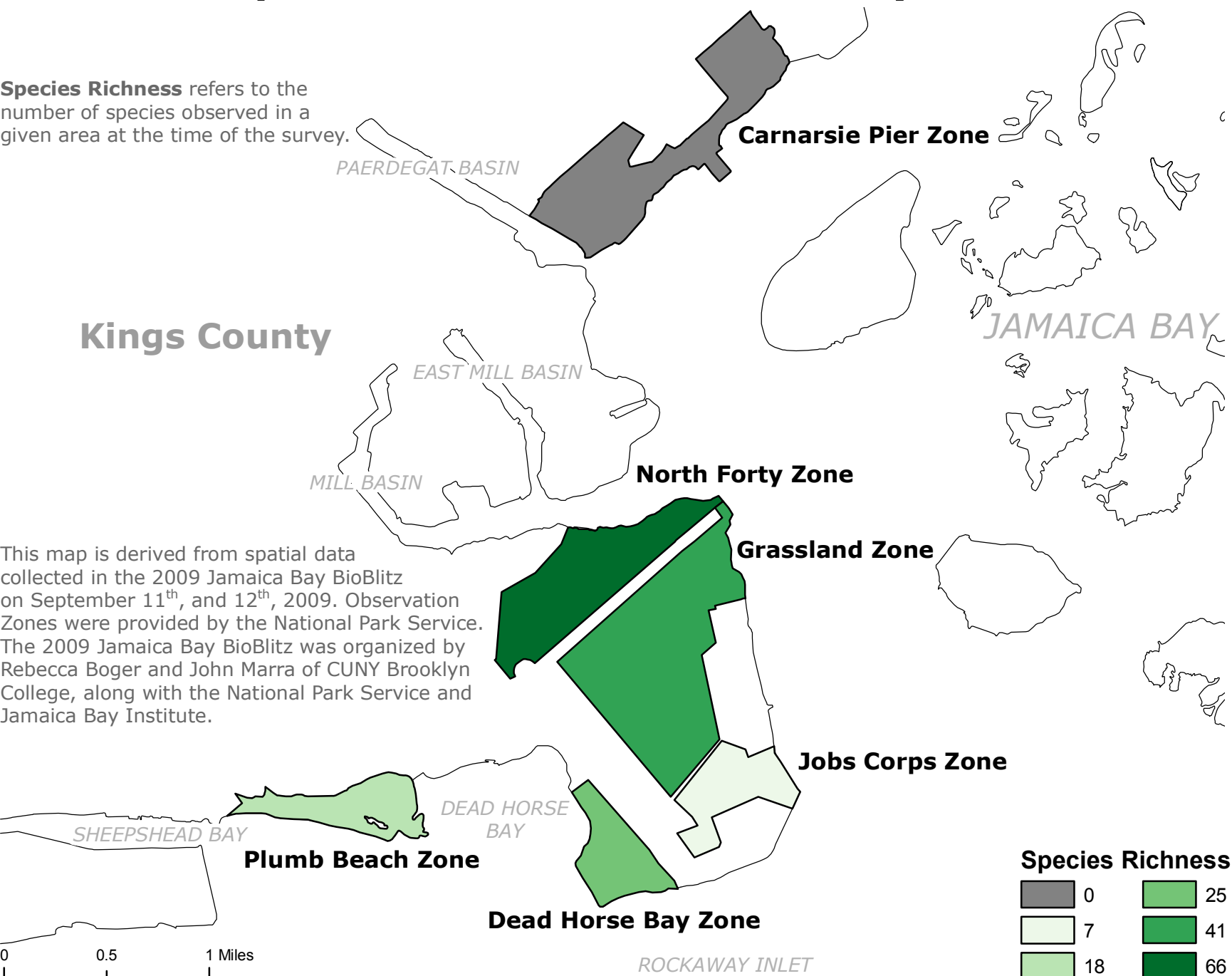


Observed Species Richness: Jamaica Bay BioBlitz 2009

Species Richness refers to the number of species observed in a given area at the time of the survey.
